Description:	CD46 is the membrane cofactor protein that serves as an inhibitory complement receptor in complement regulatory cascade. It acts as a cofactor for complement factor I, a serine protease which protects autologous cells against complement-mediated injury by cleaving C3b and C4b deposited on host tissue. It also acts as a costimulatory factor for T-cells which induces the differentiation of CD4+ into T-regulatory 1 cells. T-regulatory 1 cells suppress immune responses by secreting interleukin-10, and therefore are thought to prevent autoimmunity. A number of viral and bacterial pathogens seem to bind MCP in order to exploit its immune regulation property and directly induce an immunosuppressive phenotype in T-cells. CD46 serves as receptor for adenovirus subgroup B2 and Ad3, cultured measles virus and herpesvirus 6, and pathogenic bacteria <i>Neisseria</i> and <i>Streptococcus pyogenes</i>.
