Description:	Programmed cell death protein 1, also known as PD-1 and CD279, functions as an immune checkpoint, plays an important role in down regulating the immune system by preventing the activation of T-cells, which in turn reduces autoimmunity and promotes self-tolerance, by interaction with its ligands PD-L1/PD-L2 on APC/Treg (or cancer) cells. The inhibitory effect of PD-1 is accomplished through a dual mechanism of promoting apoptosis (programmed cell death) in antigen specific T-cells in lymph nodes while simultaneously reducing apoptosis in regulatory T cells (suppressor T cells).
